Fact Sheet

Newport Beach, California is a coastal wonderland located on a scenic, 10-mile stretch of pristine Southern California coast between Los Angeles and San Diego. With year-round Mediterranean climate, this idyllic town is a world-class destination for family fun, romance, and more – offering unparalleled opportunities for sightseeing, outdoor activities, water sports, fabulous dining, world-class shopping, and entertainment. In addition, a wide array of annual community events celebrating culinary arts, cinema, classic motorcars and more, ensure that there’s something for everyone in Newport Beach.

Total Area

50 square miles: 25 miles of water / 15 miles of land / 10 miles of coastline.

Location

Situated 45 miles south of Los Angeles, 90 miles north of San Diego and 26 miles from Catalina Island, centered in the middle of the Orange County coastline.

Accessibility

Newport Beach is directly adjacent to John Wayne Airport (SNA); Long Beach Airport (is located 20 miles north); and Los Angeles International Airport (is located 45 miles north).

Climate

Year-round temperatures average about 67 degrees Fahrenheit/19.35 degrees Celsius (coldest reaches an average low of 49 in December, hottest, a high of 72 in August).

- Approximately 3,345 hotel rooms and 200,000 square feet of indoor and outdoor meeting space under a variety of branded and independent hotel flags.
- There are over 450 restaurants in Newport Beach.



- At just over 3 miles long, Newport Beach is one of the largest small-craft harbors in the U.S. with 7 residential islands and almost 9,000 privately owned yachts & sailboats. There really isn't another harbor like it between San Diego and San Francisco!
